Climate change and how to adapt in the Southern Sierra Nevada will be the focus of a workshop hosted by Sequoia Riverlands Trust, the Southern Sierra Regional Water Management Group and Provost and Pritchard Consulting Group to be held June 5, 1:00-4:30 at Provost & Pritchard's Fresno location.

This event is open to the public and free of charge.

The goals of the workshop are to provide an understanding of climate change and the potential impacts in the southern Sierra. Speakers will also describe the potential mitigation, adaptation strategies and ways to improve resiliency identified in a recent climate change impacts report by the GEOS Institute for the Southern Sierra Regional Water Management Group.

Participants will also provide feedback to the Southern Sierra Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWMP) through additional water management strategies that may apply to the Sierra and help set important priorities for responding to climate change in the IRWMP.
